A week and a half ago, we hope you noticed something different in our worship service. Following the announcements, there was a little item labeled, "God Sighting." During this time, Marionna Harbin fearlessly stood and shared about a new program at our church called, "Food For Thought." She shared how it had impacted her, the impact she'd seen on the children, and especially on a young girl named Emily. And she shared how God had shown up.

At Food For Thought, we saw God show up. The Spirit showed up in opening doors for the program to start, and in inspiring volunteers to provide food, to teach, and to organize. We watched, amazed, as this little program on Wednesday afternoons encouraged teachers at Hollywood Elementary. It touched the hearts of those who helped. Beyond our expectations, we connected with the children and were blessed by their joy and friendship. When small gestures leap like this, you have to step back and say, "God showed up."

That is a God Sighting.

We added the "God Sighting" into the worship service because we are convicted that God is working in the world. He is showing up all over the place, driving the God-bus into town with the Holy Spirit and Jesus at the wheel. God is working in our families, our church, our community.

And it is so important that we notice when God shows up.

By sharing these moments when they happen, we can all be reminded that God is living and active in the world. So, from time to time we will have these, "God Sightings," in the service. These are not pastoral moments. They are from all of you.

If there is a moment, something that happens and you just think, "God showed up," write it down. No matter what, it is a moment worth remembering. But it's also a moment worth sharing. Consider letting some friends or family members know.

But—if you really feel bold, and we hope you will—let us know. We'll try to fit you into a, "God Sighting," on a Sunday morning. We're even willing to help you work through how to tell the story.

Because God shows up. And it's so important we don't miss it when He does.


