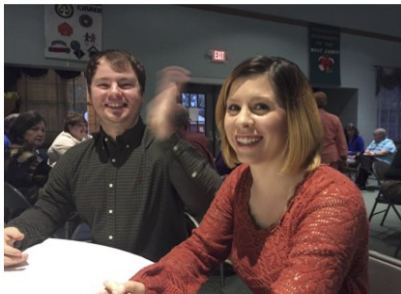


This past Saturday our church had the wonderful opportunity to host the Scottsboro Community Band for an evening concert. The cost of a ticket got you a delicious meal from Mud Creek BBQ, a homemade dessert, and about an hour of superb music. From circus tunes to pieces paying tribute to old-time community bands, our Fellowship Hall was bouncing with energy and joy. All proceeds were split between the Community Band for supplies and our own mission's program. It was

suggested the funds would be of great use to the school in Guatemala that our church visited this July. Because they run off of donations, they regularly find themselves unable to pay their teachers' salaries. What we raised will be able to pay a teacher's salary for a couple months!

During the course of the night, we learned that the Community Band is open to any musicians in town, high school and older. It currently includes students through professional musicians, and every kind of music-lover in between. Clarinets, trumpets, flutes, trombones, were joined by a sousaphone, snare drum and bass drum, all under

CHOIR TRYOUTS!!??!!



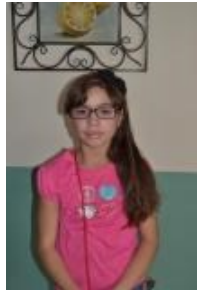
It's not what you think! We want YOU to try out choir.

Room In The Inn

Wow!! It's November already. December will soon be here. The Board of Directors for Room In The Inn (RITI) has been meeting this summer. RITI will begin on December 1, 2016.

RITI is a program that brings churches of Jackson County together during the coldest months of the year to help those in our community who are a little down on their luck. We, SCPC, will once again serve as a Host Church, to open our doors to the homeless, to welcome them as guests, to provide a hot meal, a warm safe place to spend the night, breakfast, and sack lunch.

This year the Board of Directors determined that we be open from December 1st through February 28th. To avoid conflict with others using the fellowship hall, we host only on Friday and Saturday nights. As it stands right now, in December we are scheduled for 2 evenings on Friday December 2nd and Saturday December 17th. In January we are scheduled for Friday January 6th and Saturday January 28th. In February we are scheduled for Saturday February 11th and Friday February 24th.

We are sharing this information with you early so you can check your schedule and consider volunteering to be a part of this ministry on one of the a fore mentioned days. The different areas where we need volunteers include picking up and returning the van, transporting guest to and from the church, setting up the hall for the evening and serving/sharing the meal with the guests, preparing the food for our guests, staying the night as the innkeeper, and preparing and serving breakfast, then cleaning up the kitchen area. Closer to the dates when we are schedules to host, sign-up sheets will be posted in the church hallway and announcements made in the Spire. If you wish to volunteer now, please e-mail me (Lil Noble at lilnoble3@yahoo.com). We would especially like to have a list of innkeepers as soon as possible, so if you are willing to spend the night, please contact me now.
